Directions for use

1. Always add Raynox Water Softener to ALL required spray water **before** adding Raynox Apple Sunburn Protectant
2. Refer to the table below to determine the amount of Raynox Water Softener to be added per 100L of spray water.

Water Hardness	Amount of Water Softener mL/100L water
50ppm	40mL
75ppm	56mL
100ppm	80mL
200ppm	160mL

3. **You MUST know the level of hardness of your spray water supply.** Have it tested before you mix Raynox Apple Sunburn Protect with the water supply. If your water hardness is above 200ppm please contact your Colin Campbell (Chemicals) P/L representative to determine the proper amount of water softener to use.
4. Mix for two minutes before adding Raynox Apple Sunburn Protectant to tank. Failure to use the correct amount of Raynox Water Softener according to label directions will result in reduced sunburn protection efficiency.

SAFETY DIRECTIONS

Harmful if swallowed. Will irritate skin. Will damage eyes. Avoid contact with eyes and skin. When opening the container and preparing the solution, wear cotton overalls buttoned to the neck or wrist (or equivalent clothing), elbow length PVC gloves and goggles. Wash hands after use.
