DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To be used in accordance with the Directions for Use panel on the Armobreak label.

Storage and Disposal

Store in the closed, original container in a dry, cool well-ventilated area. Do not store for prolonged periods in direct sunlight. Triple or, preferably, pressure rinse containers before disposal. Add rinsings to spray tank. Do not dispose of undiluted chemicals on-site. If recycling, replace cap and return clean containers to recycler or designated collection point. If not recycling, break, crush or puncture and bury empty containers in a local authority landfill. If no landfill is available, bury the empty containers below 500mm in a disposal pit specifically marked and set up for this purpose clear of waterways, desirable vegetation and tree roots. Empty containers and products should not be burnt. Spills should be immobilised on absorbent material such as sawdust, vermiculite or dry sand and disposed of at an approved site.

Safety Directions

Harmful if inhaled or swallowed. Will irritate the eyes and skin. Avoid contact with eyes and skin. When opening the container and preparing the spray and using the prepared spray, wear elbow-length PVC gloves and disposable mist mask. Wash hands after use. After each day's use, wash gloves.
