GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Do NOT use on Buffalo, Kikuyu, Queensland Blue Couch, Carpet or Centipede grass as injury will occur. In hot weather temporary yellowing may occur. Risk of damage increases with temperatures over 30°C. Injury will also occur on Bent or Fescues if the recommended rates are exceeded. Passtox Flowable is most effective on actively growing weeds at air temperatures above 21°C. Do NOT treat new lawns until after 3 mowings.

MIXING: Add the required amount of Passtox Flowable to water and stir thoroughly until dissolved. Then add Ultrawet as required. Do NOT store spray solution in tank for prolonged periods.

For weed resistance management Passtox Flowable is a group K herbicide. Some naturally occurring weed biotypes resistant to Passtox Flowable and other herbicides with diverse sites of action may exist through normal genetic variability in any weed population. The resistant individuals can eventually dominate the weed population if these herbicides are used repeatedly. These resistant weeds will not be controlled by Passtox Flowable or other herbicides with diverse sites of action. Since the occurrence of resistant weeds is difficult to detect prior to use, Colin Campbell (Chemicals) Pty. Ltd. accepts no liability for any losses that may result from the failure of Passtox Flowable to control resistant weeds.

PROTECTION OF LIVESTOCK

DO NOT feed grass clippings from treated areas to poultry or other animals. Do not allow livestock to graze treated area.

PROTECTION OF WILDLIFE, FISH, CRUSTACEAN AND ENVIRONMENT

Toxic to fish. Do not contaminate streams, rivers or waterways with the chemical or used container.

PROTECTION OF CROPS, NATIVE AND NON-TARGET PLANTS

Do not apply under weather conditions or from spraying equipment which may cause spray to drift onto nearby susceptible plants, crops, crop lands or pastures.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in the closed original container in a well ventilated area, as cool as possible out of direct sunlight. Store in a locked room or place away from children, animals, food, feedstuffs, seed and fertilizers. Triple or preferably pressure rinse containers before disposal. Add rinsings to spray tank. Do not dispose of undiluted chemicals onsite. Break, crush, puncture and bury empty containers in a local authority landfill. If not available bury the containers below 500mm in a disposal pit specifically marked and set up for this purpose clear of waterways, vegetation and roots. Empty containers and product should not be burnt.

SAFETY DIRECTIONS

Poisonous if absorbed by skin contact or swallowed. May irritate the eyes and skin. Avoid contact with eyes and skin. When preparing spray and using the prepared spray wear cotton overalls buttoned to the neck and wrist and a washable hat and rubber gloves. After use and before eating, drinking or smoking, wash hands, arms and face thoroughly with soap and water. After each days use, wash gloves and contaminated clothing.
