Domestic Lawn	African black beetle	NSW, Qld, SA, WA, Vic only	15mL in 10L water per 10 square metres	Before treatment mow lawn ensuring no flowers are present. Repeat application as necessary. Immediately after application irrigate the treated area with the equivalent of 1mm water.
	Mole cricket	SA, Qld, NSW only	20mL in 10L water per 10 square metres	
	Grass-eating caterpillars, e.g Armyworms, webworms, cutworms	Qld, NSW, Vic, WA only	3mL in 1L water per 10 square metres.	Before treatment mow lawn ensuring no flowers are present. Repeat application as necessary.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS: Shake container before pouring.

PROTECTION OF LIVESTOCK, FISH AND ENVIRONMENT: Do not graze treated turf or feed grass-clippings from treated area to poultry or animals. Dangerous to bees. Do not spray any plants in flower while bees are foraging. Dangerous to fish. Do not contaminate ponds, waterways, irrigation channels or drains with the product or used container.

STORAGE, DISPOSAL, AND PROTECTION OF OTHERS: Store in original container tightly closed in a dry well ventilated area, as cool as possible out of direct sunlight. Do not store with fertilizers, insecticides, fungicides and seeds. Protect product from frost. Dispose of empty containers by wrapping in paper, placing in a plastic bag and putting in garbage.

SAFETY DIRECTIONS: Avoid contact with skin. When opening the container and preparing the spray, and using the prepared spray, wear elbow-length PVC gloves. After use and before eating, drinking or smoking wash hands, arms and face thoroughly with soap and water. After each days use, wash gloves.
