Rates Of Application:

On Couch or similar stoloniferous grasses 1.5 kg in 50-75 litres of water per 100m² every 3-4 weeks.

On Bent Grasses 1.2 kg per 50-75 litres of water per 100m² every 3-4 weeks.

Compatibility: The combination of Ultragreen with pesticides is not recommended.
